Neighborhood Purposes Grants

Neighborhood Purposes Grants (NPGs) provide NCs opportunities to develop partnerships with local 501(c)(3) nonprofits and public schools to build community and enhance neighborhoods in the City of Los Angeles. Projects and activities supported by NPGs vary widely and can include, but are not limited to:

- The Arts
- Beautification
- Community Support
- Education
- Community Improvements

NPG-funded projects and activities must be for a *public benefit* and purpose, **open**, *accessible*, and *free of charge* to stakeholders.

Grants approved by NCs exceeding \$5,000 involve further review and possible City contract by the Office of the City Clerk.

There are two NPG Information Packets; One for prospective applicants to help guide them in the application process, and one for NC board members outlining considerations and factors to keep in mind while evaluating NPG requests.

A "Project Completion Report" template is also provided to help ensure accountability in the use of Grant funds and help demonstrate how NCs and their partners are supporting L.A. communities and stakeholders. NCs and NPG recipients are strongly encouraged to work together to complete and submit the Report at the conclusion of the project.

SECTION II - PROJECT DESCRIPTION

4) Please describe the purpose and intent of the grant.

THE PURPOSE AND INTENT OF THE GRANT IS TO PRODUCE THE FIRST-EVER HACKATHON FOR VENICE YOUTH THAT IS OPEN, ACCESSIBLE, AND FREE TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC. A HACKATHON IS A COLLABORATIVE INVENTION EDUCATION COMPETITION THAT PROVIDES YOUTH WITH MENTOR-GUIDED BLENDED LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS FOR PROJECT-BASED EDUCATION AND EXPLORATION OF CAREERS PATHWAYS IN SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, ARTS, AND MATH, ESPECIALLY THROUGH THE LENS OF ENTREPRENEURSHIP. HACKER FUND IS THE NATION'S LEADING HACKATHON PRODUCER, SERVING 60K+ STUDENTS WITH A TEAM OF 150+ TECHNOLOGY COMPANIES. THIS HACKATHON — VENICE HACK DAY — WILL TAKE PLACE IN OCTOBER 2024 AT A LOCAL VENUE ACCESSIBLE TO UP TO 100 STUDENTS AGES 13-25 (IE. THE VENICE SKILLS CENTER) FOR A MAXIMUM TEN-HOUR PERIOD (8AM - 6PM) AND WILL BE PRODUCED BY OUR LOS ANGELES MENTOR CHAPTER THAT INCLUDES ELITE INDUSTRY PROFESSIONALS FROM TOP TECHNOLOGY COMPANIES INCLUDING GOOGLE, MICROSOFT, APPLE, SNAP, TINDER, TESLA, AND SPACEX. THIS GRANT WILL FUND SUPPLIES, SUPPORT STAFF, AND EQUIPMENT THAT WILL PROVIDE VENICE YOUTH WITH AN ENVIRONMENT FOR OFFICE HOURS, COMPUTER SCIENCE WORKSHOPS, ART DESIGN SPRINTS, AND A DEMO DAY WHERE THEY SHOWCASE TECHNOLOGY SKILLS, DEVELOP THEIR PORTFOLIOS, AND BUILD RELATIONSHIPS WITH CREATIVE PROFESSIONALS WHO CAN OFFER THEM INTERNSHIPS AND JOBS.

5) How will this grant be used to primarily support or serve a public purpose and benefit the public at-large. (Grants cannot be used as rewards or prizes for individuals)

THIS GRANT WILL FUNDAMENTALLY SERVE A PUBLIC PURPOSE BY FOSTERING COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AND ENHANCING THE NEIGHBORHOOD THROUGH YOUTH ENTREPRENEURSHIP. AS LEADERS IN INVENTION EDUCATION, OUR TEAM HAS DEVELOPED A REALISTIC AND FEASIBLE BUDGET FOR A WORK PLAN THAT IS ENTHUSIASTICALLY SUPPORTED BY COMMUNITY STAKEHOLDERS, INCLUDING THE LA MAYOR'S OFFICE AND LAUSD SCHOOLS LIKE VENICE HIGH SCHOOL THAT HAVE PARTNERED WITH US SINCE 2014. OUR REPUTATION IS BOLSTERED BY OUR SUCCESSFUL COORDINATION OF COMMUNITY EVENTS LIKE THE VENICE HOLIDAY SIGN LIGHTING AND THE WAVE AWARDS POWERED BY THE VENICE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE. THIS GRANT WILL BE INSTRUMENTAL IN LAUNCHING THE FIRST-EVER "VENICE HACK DAY", A PIONEERING INITIATIVE THAT MATCHES THE COMMUNITY'S DESIRE FOR INNOVATIVE EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES. THIS EVENT WILL BUILD A SUSTAINABLE WORKFORCE AND WILL HELP VENICE YOUTH DEVELOP SKILLS CRITICAL FOR THE EMERGING JOB MARKET, THEREBY SUPPORTING A BROADER VENICE RENAISSANCE. ADDITIONALLY, IT WILL OFFER INTERNSHIPS AND APPRENTICESHIPS, DIRECTLY BENEFITING UP TO 100 YOUTH AND INDIRECTLY IMPACTING THE COMMUNITY AT LARGE THROUGH THEIR FAMILIES THAT ARE INVESTING IN YOUTH EDUCATION AS VENICE RESIDENTS. WE ARE REQUESTING A \$5K GRANT IN ORDER TO SUPPLEMENT THE \$10K OUR FUNDERS HAVE ALREADY COMMITTED TO HELP UNDERWRITE THE TOTAL COST OF \$15K FOR THIS PROJECT.
