Venice Dual Force Main Project

Construction of a new 54-inch diameter force main sewer line to operate as a parallel system in conjunction with the existing sewer line. The project will increase capacity, create pipeline redundancy and allow for maintenance.

Construction Activities scheduled for August 2017 through September 2017
Overall Project Dates: Spring 2017 through Summer 2020

What work is planned for August 2017 through September 2017?	Pre-excavation of the shaft; concrete and asphalt demolition; equipment and material deliveries; jet grouting and secant pile drilling; DWP power relocation for the Venice Pumping Plant.
Where is the construction area?	Activities will occur at the following location: Hurricane Street at Canal Court.
What time are crews scheduled to work?	Expected work hours are: City of Los Angeles: Mon – Fri, 8am – 5pm
What can I expect?	Noise associated with heavy equipment and drilling; 80 feet tall drill rig; large excavator; construction traffic with large equipment deliveries and dump trucks; vibration due to concrete and asphalt demolition.
Is local access impacted?	Through traffic will be maintained for local traffic access at all times. Driveway access will be maintained for businesses and residents for deliveries and trash pickup.
Safety Measures (to protect the public and construction crew)	Appropriate traffic handling measures will be implemented to safely divert traffic through the construction zone. Safety barriers will be used in all construction areas.
