Instructions:

Community Interest Stakeholders (Community Interest Stakeholders are defined as those who declare a stake in the neighborhood as a community interest stakeholder, defined as a person who affirms a substantial and ongoing participation within the Neighborhood Council's boundaries and who may be in a community organization such as, but not limited to, educational, non-profit and/or religious organizations.) are welcomed to apply for consideration for the Community Interest Stakeholder Officer's position on the Venice Neighborhood Council (VNC) Board of Officers.

Applicants shall provide a written statement explaining how they comply with the definition above.

NOTE: Stakeholders who live, work, or own property within the VNC boundaries **CANNOT** apply for consideration for the Community Interest Stakeholder Officer's position.

Nominations were opened at the October 17th Board meeting at which time applications will be available as well as online at : [Click here for application](#) . They must be returned by email to john.reed@venicenc.org by **November 13th** or brought to the VNC Adcom meeting on Monday, **November 13th** at Extra Space Storage, President's Row Room 658 South Venice Blvd, Venice, 90291, at which time the nominations will be closed. The Board will select a new member at the **November 21st** Board meeting held at Westminster Elementary School, 1010 Abbot Kinney Blvd, starting at 7pm. Applicants need to show proof that they are stakeholders either at the Adcom or Board meetings and will give a short presentation at the Board meeting. No representatives will be permitted to speak for the applicant.
