

## **Motion to Support Native plants and trees on Rose Ave. at Penmar Golf Course**

Whereas the Venice Community has expressed a desire for the stretch of Rose Avenue along the Penmar Golf Course to have substantial natural elements and to allow recreation on this stretch of road for walkers and runners:

Now be it therefore resolved, the Venice Neighborhood Council resolves that native species and large trees to create green space, shade and habitat for native fauna are preferable for the choices to be made by city architects. The least amount of concrete should be employed to comply with ADA requirements, thus affording the use of large tree species as per the attached letter from experienced native tree expert, Charles Miller.

Following passage this Resolution shall be forwarded to Mayor Karen Bass, Councilwoman Traci Park, general managers of the Department of Public Works and the Department of Transportation, as well as project architect Alexander Caiozzo.
