

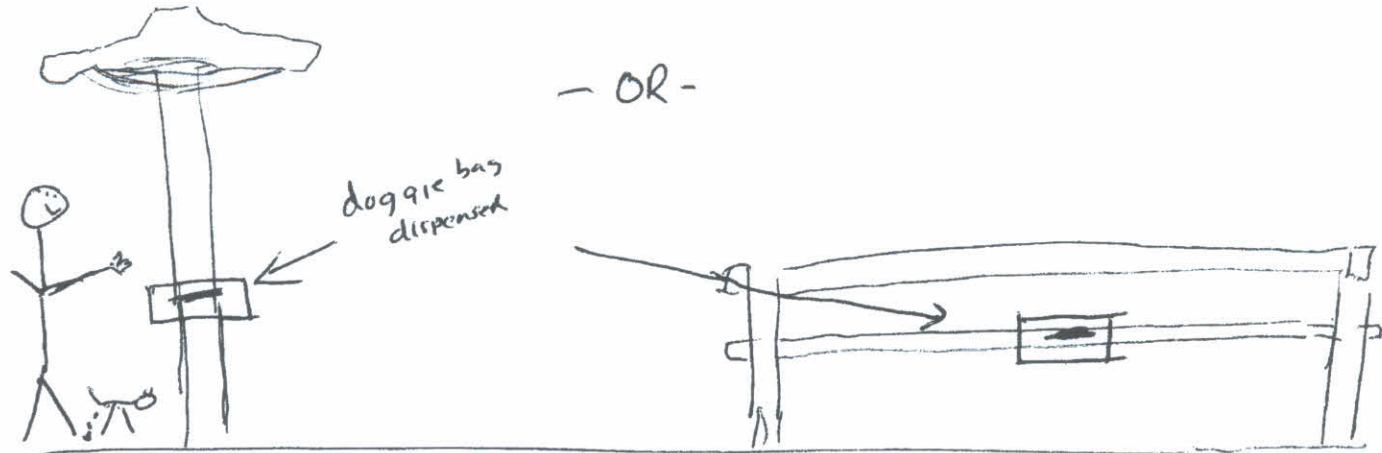

Sorry for not getting back to you sooner Steve but I wanted to review the map and clarify which city departments would be involved.

For the ones on Ocean Front Walk, that would be our City's Recreation & Parks. The problem with that at this juncture, while we may be able to get their approval to have the dispensers installed, Recreation & Parks has relayed that at this juncture they don't have funding and/or the staff for future upkeep and/or maintenance. Perhaps that's something volunteers would/could assist with.

For the ones near the Grand Canal and the Ballona Lagoon, same scenario. While we could get Street Services to approve, we will have a challenge with maintenance and/or upkeep as there are no units beyond our Recreation & Parks that do this work.

So, all this being said, feel free to let me know how you would like us to proceed. Basically, we could work with the appropriate city unit for placement/installation, upkeep and maintenance will be an issue at this juncture.

One of my first assignments is the Doggie Bag Dispenser project which would allow us to attach box type units to poles and/or fences that would dispense plastic bags for dog owners to clean up after their pets. I have attached a proposed map area on the peninsula of where we are thinking of putting these dispensers

I am applying for the funds for this project thru the Venice Community Improvement Project, but fear I may have missed the application deadline of Oct 3rd and was hoping to get some leniency on this deadline...I think it is a viable project for this type of grant, and would love for it to be considered. If you can help me obtain this leniency, I would love to apply still. Please let me know.

In any case, I would like to know what we have to do to obtain permission to complete this project in the areas I have outlined on the map attached.

Also, I would like to find out about who may be ultimately responsible for refilling these boxes with bags if the project does eventually get funded and completed. Is it possible that the city or county would be on board with us to refill these bags as an ongoing part of the regular servicing the city or county may already provide to the community at large.

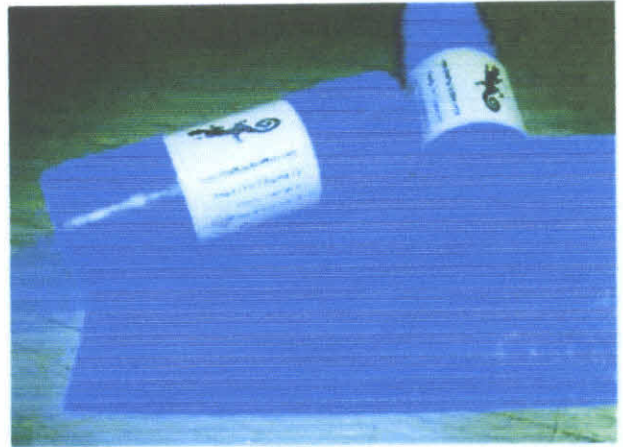

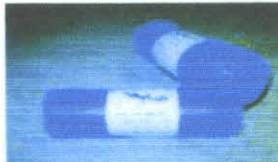
