Last evening and/or early this morning, five and possibly eight incidents of vandalism, involving parked cars/pick-up truck, occurred on or adjacent to Dell Avenue. Each car had one tire damaged. The cause can be a puncture, slash, or possibly air released, which is difficult to determine by looking at it. Three of the cars are believed to have already been moved.

Locations: At the end of the 200 block of Carroll Canal Court near Dell Avenue. Across from the park on Dell Avenue. At the end of the 200 block of Linnie Canal Court, around the corner on the 2400 block of Dell. At the end of the 200 block of Howland Canal Court, a car parked on the 2500 block of Dell. On the 2300 block of Dell, a black pick-up was "keyed" (vandalized by scratching with an object) along the side and the hood.

The incidents were discussed with the Security Services System (SSS) Community Bike Patrol Officer Alan Herrera, and this e-mail information will be sent to the LAPD Officer Robin Richards, Senior Lead Officer, Pacific Area, and SSS owner, George Aceves. Officer Richards and Mr. Aceves have also been called.
